

# Waupoosee Township Grundy County, Illinois

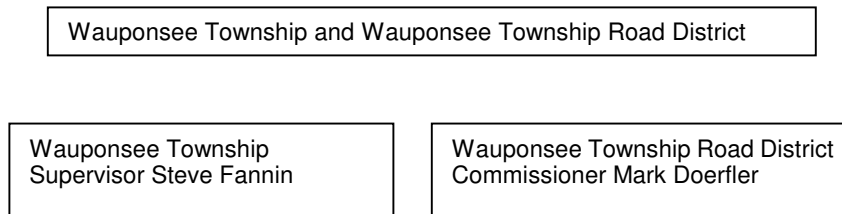
The **Waupoosee Township** and **Waupoosee Township Road District** have no inherent power other than those granted to them by the Illinois Constitution or authorized by statute. The electors provide orders to the township board at an annual or special town meeting as set forth by statute.

The township provides three mandatory functions, which include administering a general assistance program, maintaining township roads and bridges and appraising property values. The property value appraisal function is provided by a multi township assessment district identified as the Norman Waupoosee Township Assessing District.

Waupoosee Township maintains one office at 20 E. Southmor Road with a 2010 operating budget of \$52,636. The elected board includes Supervisor Steven Fannin, Trustees Tom Baker, Jeff Carr, Neil Romines, Tom Sparrow and Clerk Charles Sargent.

Waupoosee Township Road and Bridge maintains one office/garage at 35 E Southmor Road; employs four part-time employees and the Road Commissioner, Mark Doerfler with an 2010 operating budget of \$349,756.
