### Road Commissioner's Report

Commissioner Doerfler presented the following report:

- The Road District received a letter from IPWMAN recognizing the support following the tornado in the Ottawa area.
- Some flooding occurred during the recent heavy rains on Pine Bluff Rd.
- The Ditch Projects scheduled for the year are going OK.
- ComEd notified the township of work scheduled in the area over the next two months. The electric feeds will be placed underground on Tracy, Plaza and Beth Drives.
- A Township resident made the Road commissioner aware the ComEd had placed a guy wire in his field.
- Consideration is being given to hiring a part time employee to fill in for a short time while the regular employee is work at his farm. The pay rate for the part time employee would be the same as the regular employee. Commissioner Doerfler asked for feedback on this plan since his farther is the short time employee. There were no major concerns expressed by the Board.
- A resident on Conley Road informed the Road Commissioner that he has a field tile in the Township ROW and he wanted the Township to repair it.
   After some discussion, the general consciences was to take no action, the option to appeal to the Board will be offered.
- Commissioner Doerfler showed a video of the ditch work in progress on Lund Road. A portion of the engineered project has a fence in the ROW. Several discussions have been held with the land owner in an attempt to resolve the issue and allow the completion of the drainage improvement Project. The issue is now to the attorney resolution phase.




