

ORDINANCE NO. 2

DUMPS

Now therefore be it ordained by the electors of the Township of Wauponee, Grundy County, Illinois:

Section 1. License required. It shall be unlawful to operate a dump or to dump material at any place without obtaining a license therefore as hereinafter provided.

Section 2. Applications. Licenses for such applications for a dumping place shall be made to the Town Clerk.

Section 3. Fee. The annual fee to be paid for such license for a dumping place shall be \$ _____.

Section 4. Dumps. Such dumping places shall in addition to the above comply with the following:

A. All decomposing or offensive material shall be covered at once and shall remain covered at all times.

B. Said township of Wauponee shall have the right to inspect said dump to be sure that the above provision as to covering decomposing or offensive material is complied with, and shall further have the right to inspect such dumping place in order to establish proper health standards.

Section 5. Inspection fee. The inspection fee shall be \$ _____ per each inspection and shall be paid by the person or organization operating said dumping place, and such dumping place shall be inspected at least once each month.

Section 6. Penalty. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than one dollar nor more than fifty dollars for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each and every day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

Section 7. The invalidity of any portion of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portion hereof which can be given effect without such invalid part.
