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## **Snow Removal Policy**

### Approved 11, February 2009

Each of the roads in Waupontsee Township has been categorized in one of the three following categories, Level One, Level Two, and Level Three. Each of these is explained below. This policy has been developed due to the increased price in the salt and sand mix used to fight snow and ice on township roads, as well as the shortage of road salt that occurred in 2008.

Level One; these are main roads that carry a lot of traffic in the township. These roads are major arteries that lead in and out of the township. By being a level one road, the salt and sand mix will be spread over the entire road in both lanes.

Level Two; these are medium traveled roads that will lead a motorist to a Level One road. These roads will have the salt and sand mixture applied to corners, hills, curves, and intersections.

Level Three; these are low volume roads that receive little to no traffic. An example of a Level Three road would be a subdivision cul-de-sac, or a dead end road. These roads will have no salt and sand mixture applied to them.

This plan will be in effect as long as Waupontsee Township Road and Bridge has enough salt and sand mixture on hand to comply with this policy. When there is not enough mixture on hand we will apply the means necessary to make the traveling public of Waupontsee Township safe.
